Only the official BSA uniform is acceptable. Be prepared for an overnight hike as well as living in camp.

Required Items

Official Scout Socks (minimum 3 pair)	Scout Handbook
Scout Belt	Pocket knife with Totem Chip Card
Hiking Shoes/Boots	Small backpack for overnight
Change of Shoes	Lightweight tent for outpost
Compass	Waterproof ground cloth
Rain Gear	Personal eating gear (fork, knife, spoon)
Canteen/Water Bottle	Sleeping bag or blankets
Fireman's Chit Card	Shower shoes (for shower use only)
Air Mattress/Pad/Cot	Flashlight with spare batteries
Shower/toilet kit, soap, toothpaste/brush	Bug Spray & Sun Block
Jacket	Sewing Kit
Bath Towels (2)	Personal First Aid Kit
Underclothing (7 pairs)	Mirror (Metal)
Swim Shorts	Wristwatch
Sleeping clothes as desired	Required/prescribed medication
Additional changes of clothing	Any item to make your stay comfortable

NOTES

- Three meals per day and an evening cracker barrel are provided. A scout with a dietary restriction needs to not his/her restrictions on the bottom of Personal Information form and the BSA medical form and email the NYLT Scoutmaster.
- The official BSA scout uniform will be worn during the course sessions.
- The BSA activity uniform will be worn during activity sessions. This uniform consists of Scout Shorts, Socks, and a BSA t-shirt. Any shirt with references to anything in poor taste or alcohol ads is not permitted.
