**STEM Scouts** focuses on **fun** ways for **girls and boys**, in grades 3–12, to learn more about **science, technology, engineering and math** (STEM). STEM Scouts features hands-on experiments, field trips and interactions with STEM professionals to help students learn academic concepts, and see how STEM skills are used in real-world jobs.



### **STEM SCOUTS AT A GLANCE:**

- STEM Labs are grouped by **elementary, middle and high school**
- Weekly 90-minute lab meetings
- Field trips
- 6- to 8-week learning modules, created by STEM educators
- New skills and character development activities
- Volunteer leader and short-term professional volunteer opportunities
- Mentoring and publishing opportunities
- Future career opportunities
  - STEM jobs are projected to grow 17% by 2018
  - STEM salaries average 26% more than non-STEM jobs
