STEM Scouts features hands-on experiments, field trips and interactions with STEM professionals to help students learn academic concepts, and see how STEM skills are used in real-world jobs.

- Mentoring and publishing opportunities
- Future career opportunities

 - STEM salaries average 26% more than non-STEM jobs
